Elijah Garrett Coffee Hope Scholarship



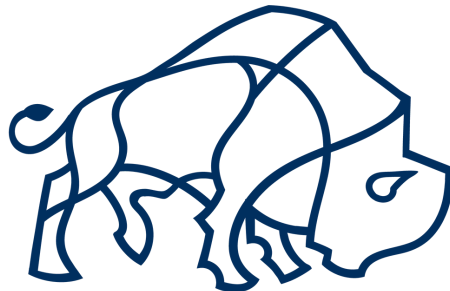
May 2, 1999 - April 16, 2021
