



SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Kismet Arts Studio & Theatre offers scholarship opportunities to assist with student tuition fees. These are offered as funding allows each semester. All applications are reviewed by the Associate Board of Directors and decisions are made without regard to gender identity, race, age, religion, or physical/intellectual characteristics.

The purpose of our scholarships is to provide support to students who have financial need and to support Kismet Arts' mission to provide an arts education program that promotes multifaceted, life-long learning to a diverse community.

KISMET PROMISE SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is available to Juniors and Seniors and is a merit-based scholarship that covers the cost of tuition for a production class.

ELIJAH GARETT COFFEE HOPE SCHOLARSHIP

Any student displaying a need for financial assistance is eligible to apply.

FINANCIAL AID GUIDELINES

Consideration is given to those students and families who display commitment, reliability, and preparedness. Each student on scholarship will be observed throughout the semester to evaluate their continued commitment to their education. Parents of and recipients of these scholarships will be asked to assist with preparation for shows throughout the semester.

Scholarships will be withdrawn if the student:

- Drops a class mid-semester after scholarship funds have been allocated.
- Continually misses class or arrives late.
- Acts out in class or is disrespectful to their peers/instructors.

PRIVATE LESSON INSTRUCTION

Private Lessons are considered supplementary and are not eligible for financial assistance, but will be considered in each family's total out of pocket expense.
