Elijah Garrett Coffee Hope Scholarship



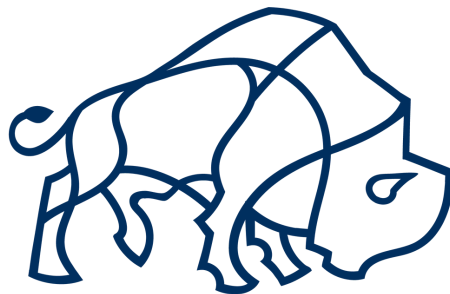
